PLANNING COMMITTEE MEETING

MINUTES of the MEETING on TUESDAY 14th MAY 2019 at 7.00PM

IN THE VILLAGE HALL LOUNGE

Present: Cllrs Morris (KM)(Chairman), Rathbone (TR)(Vice-Chairman), Beckham (NB), Lord (SM), Roberts (DR) and Williams (EW).

NOTE: Councillors signed their declaration of office and code of conduct forms in the presence of the Clerk before the meeting started.

1. **Declarations of Interest** – There were no declarations of interest.
2. **Apologies for Absence** - There were no apologies for absence.
3. **Minutes of the Meeting of 23rd April 2019 – Resolved:** *The minutes of the Meeting of 23rd April were accepted as a true record of the meeting.*
4. **Planning Applications**
 - **19/1822C** – 2 Booth Bed Lane – Single storey side extension – Comments due by 21st May 2019. **Decision:** *No objection.*
 - **19/1851M** - Jodrell Bank Observatory - Application to improve safety of pedestrian and vehicular movement - Minor external alterations as follows: New road markings - including zebra crossings, junctions and pedestrian walkways, road and directional signage, new pathways, reinstating existing tarmac paths, replacing existing guardrails at building entrances/exits and increasing width of access road – Comments due by 30th May 2019. **Decision:** *Support the Application – the Neighbourhood Plan Plan Policy SC1 generally supports developments at Jodrell Bank.*
 - **19/1925C** - SPORTS GROUND EAST OF, BOOTH BED LANE - Construction of a replacement bowling hut – Comments due by 15th May 2019. **Decision:** *Support the Application – the Neighbourhood Plan Policy CF2 supports enhancement of sports and recreation facilities.*
5. **Sibelco Sand Quarry** - The Chairman commented that following the decision of the Secretary of State not to call in the application, the Parish Council would be able to keep up a dialog with Sibelco on all matters relating to the quarry via the liaison group, on which the Parish Council would have a seat.
6. **Update on Planning Enforcement Issues**
 - Waste Site – There Clerk reported that there had been no further update on the status of site from Cheshire East Planning Enforcement.
