An update from Sibelco

Site preparation at Rudheath Lodge Quarry

Dear Neighbour,

I am pleased to provide a second update regarding progress at the Sibelco Rudheath Lodge Quarry Development.

The inaugural Community Liaison Meeting was held on 15th October with representatives from each of the four local Parish Councils alongside representatives from both Cheshire East and Cheshire West & Chester councils. This positive forum allows for Sibelco and the community to engage through the Parish Councillors and Elected Members for the Ward. The first act of the meeting was to establish a Chair and Vice Chairperson, Councillor Kolker and Councillor Morgan have been appointed to these positions respectively. Updates from the meeting and the programme of forthcoming meetings are available from your Parish Council.

We continue to make progress with the plant site construction. Vegetation and tree clearance has been complete, fencing works complete and the package of work for the plant site groundworks has been issued. For each of these works, local contractors have been appointed and the timber from the plant site sold to the sawmills in Goostrey. As you may recall, the new development extends to both side of New Platt Lane. The plant site which is to the North of New Platt Lane is now fully fenced. The fencing is a mixture of acoustic and security fencing with additional live willow screening which will be planted along the Eastern aspect in November.

In November Sibelco will undertake a further litter pick and spring bulb planting to maintain the positive aesthetics around the plant site and along New Platt Lane.

Forthcoming works include: Concrete works for the plant standing and roadways, Construction of the processing plant, Advanced planting of hedgerows and tree screening works, Establishment of the quarry extraction including advanced ditch works and creation of screening bunds, Highway improvements along New Platt Lane and at the junction of A50 including a permissive path along a section of New Platt Lane. I hope to give a more detailed update of these works in the new year. Should you have any queries in the meantime please get in touch and I will do my best to ensure a prompt reply.
