GOOSTREY VILLAGE HALL

Improvements - The bar servery renewal and lighting projects at the Village Hall which were scheduled to be carried out in April, but which were delayed by "lockdown", have now been completed. We are confident that when the time comes for the Village Hall to re-open our customers will be delighted with the new look bar servery and the new LED panel lighting in the main hall and spot lights in the hall and lounge. School Use of the Main Hall - The Village Hall Management Committee recommended to the Parish Council that as the Village Hall is unable to open at the moment due to social distancing restrictions, that we offer full use of the Main Hall to the school from 15th June until the end of the summer term in July. At the May Parish Council Meeting this motion was approved and the hall is now available whenever more space is needed for the children who returned to school in June.
