Goostrey Parish Council is looking for a resourceful and experienced individual to be our new Parish Clerk and Responsible Financial Officer and to help us to run and develop the Parish Council activities and services.

We are a council supporting a community of 2,000 residents in the village and parish of Goostrey in the heart of the Cheshire countryside. In support of the many clubs and societies, we also have responsibility for bookings and maintenance of the village hall (which

is a facility shared with the primary school). We hold the 'Quality' status in the Local Council Award Scheme and are aiming to achieve the 'Quality Gold' status.

As Parish Clerk you will be the Proper Officer and Responsible Financial Officer, assisting the Council in making and implementing decisions, liaising with other bodies such as Cheshire East Borough Council, overseeing the hiring of the village hall, engaging with residents, and managing one or two members of staff. Ideally you will hold CiLCA (Certificate in Local Council Administration) or equivalent or be willing to achieve this qualification. The post involves some evening work, in particular for the monthly Parish Council meetings and for the 4 Committee meetings which vary between monthly and quarterly.

The SpeedWatch Group recommenced SpeedWatch sessions in July, with the relaxation of Government Restrictions. The data from our regular monthly reports shows that drivers regularly exceed the speed limit when travelling through our village. To increase

the deterrent to speeding drivers it is clear that we need more people to support SpeedWatch and the Parish Council would like to encourage more residents to join the team.
