SPEEDWATCH

Following an appeal in the last issue of the Parish Magazine, a Speedwatch volunteer has come forward. This is encouraging and we now only need two more volunteers to create a full team and begin running the sessions again.

Sessions are usually one hour long and take place at one of the five or six locations in the village which are approved by the police for Speedwatch purposes. Sessions can take place at a time and frequency to suit volunteers but must be in daylight and one or more sessions per month is best.

The Police and the PCSO are very supportive and a short training may be given at the start of the first session by the PCSO. Volunteers do have to read the official guidelines and to sign up to complying with them. Please contact the Clerk if you would like to join the team.
