Footway improvement work

What is happening

We are pleased to inform you that we will be carrying out pedestrian access upgrades along Main Road, Goostrey.

Why is it happening

Works to deliver pedestrian access improvements are scheduled to start on 03 April, and will take 2 weeks to complete.

When it's happening

The works will take approximately 2 weeks to complete, commencing on 03 April 2023 excluding weekends.

Under current Health & Safety legislation and for the safety of our workforce and members of the public, it will be necessary for temporary traffic signals and footway closure to be in place during these works.

We understand there is no right time to undertake this work however, the scheme has been carefully planned to minimise any inconvenience to you and other road users. Please note that we occasionally have to change our works at short notice due to unforeseen circumstances such as adverse weather conditions or logistics.

What you can expect

- Signage on street in advance of the work starting
- Our team working on the carriageway
- Machinery and vehicles
- Barrired areas to create safe working zones, in line with current Health & Safety legislation
- 'Business open as usual' signs

Access to your property or business

We will make every effort to maintain vehicle access to your property or business. If you have any specific access requirements, please raise these with our site supervisor as soon as possible.

Your safety and the safety of our workforce is our priority. Our Traffic Management Officers will be supplied with CCTV cameras and they will assist you as the work progresses.
