GOOSTREY CHRISTMAS LIGHTS

The Parish Council hopes that everyone enjoyed the new Christmas lights on The Bogbean. This year the lights were also set to come on for a short time in the mornings to cheer up the work commute or walk to school. As mentioned in previous articles, the Amenities Committee will review the lights and decide whether further work is required and if the funding is available to do this. The committee will also discuss what form the Christmas Lights Switch On event will take in 2024 as the Scouts have decided not to continue with this due to low numbers of volunteers. The Parish Council have supported the event financially over the years and will consider what can be done going forward.

SENIORS' CHRISTMAS LUNCH

The Seniors' Christmas Lunch was a great success with everyone making it to the Village Hall in spite of the inclement (though very festive) weather. HIGHWAYS LIAISON MEETING UPDATE

The second Highways Liaison meeting was held at the end of November with the local Highways Officer. Items of note include confirmation from the Officer that road markings at the Cross Lane/Bomish Lane crossroads will be re-instated and that he was awaiting a start date from the company who will carry out the work. Following the most recent near miss at this junction, the Road Safety Team have been asked by Cllr. Andrew Kolker, Cheshire East Council Ward Councillor, to look at the road safety issue in this area and they have agreed. Slurry seal work to address the issue of loose chippings on the path at Sandy Lane causing the path to become uneven has been placed on a list for future schemes. It has been confirmed that depleted white lining at junctions in the village, particularly Boothbed, Hermitage and Main Road junction will take place. Residents may have noticed the barriers at Shearbrook Bridge, Highways are monitoring the bank there and considering the need for remedial works. The next meeting will take place in March.
