Response



5 seconds

The average time to answer emergency calls

92% of emergency incidents attended in **15 minutes** Up **1%**

87% of prompt incidents attended in **60 minutes** Up **3%**

Compared to **7 seconds** in the same period last year.

5,262 arrests made up by **3%**

3,158 stop & searches up by **8%**

Overall action taken **24%** up by **4%**

Sexual Offences overall action taken **23%** up by **3%**

Overall crime rate across Cheshire down by **12%**

You Said:

Community raised concerns about speeding vehicles.

We Did:

PCSO Chadwick has been conducting TruCam activity throughout the month. This involves utilizing a speed device on our top priority locations as requested on Residents voice survey by you. Brereton Rural.

You Said:

Community raised concerns about anti-social behaviour.

We Did:

We have given extra attention to these areas to provide a visible deterrent and spoken to residents to reassure and given advice on how to contact us if necessary.

Our local PCSO met a number of residents to discuss what and when incidents were taking place, from this information "Hot Spot" policing activity was completed.

Dane Valley.

You Said:

The community raised concerns regarding speeding vehicles across the ward.

We Did:

We conducted speed enforcement at various sites including:

London Road, Macclesfield Road, Station Road, Goostrey Lane, and New Platt Lane.

Ettiley Heath & Wheelock.

You Said:

Community raised concerns relating to the misuse of drugs in the area.

We Did:

Following reports of drug use, warrants were conducted at various addresses cross the ward. These resulted in the seizure of drugs, charges and prosecutions for those responsible, so that we have a safer community to live and work in.
