

LOST PROPERTY

FOOD WASTE

If you are a regular hirer of the Village Hall then you may already have noticed the new food waste caddies in the Lounge kitchen and Committee Room. From 31st March all workplaces (businesses and non-domestic premises) in England have a legal duty to separate waste in accordance with their waste collector. Our waste collector will continue to sort dry mixed waste from the main bins so general waste and recycling can be put into the bins labelled General Waste. All food waste must be disposed of in the caddies provided in the Committee Room and Lounge kitchen or in the wheelie bin (red with a green lid) marked Food Waste outside the back door of the kitchen. Posters indicating what constitutes food waste have been placed next to the caddies.
