BOOTH BED LANE PLAY AREA DEVELOPMENT UPDATE

It has been a while since you heard anything on the redevelopment of the Booth Bed Lane Play Area. In early 2025 a funding bid for £100,000 was made to add to the £40,000 already allocated. Unfortunately, this was not successful in that round but was resubmitted for consideration in June 2025. To inform the bid, five play companies on Cheshire East Council's preferred supplier list were asked to tender for the project. Two submissions were received to deliver a scheme within a set budget (which assumed the funding bid would be successful). One company's scheme was selected based on an outline design which can be viewed on posters in the noticeboards around the village and at the play area itself. This image however will not be the final design, for example, much of the equipment will be wooden and the final design will be revised based on our survey feedback and budget. Further information will follow.
