PRIMROSE CHASE

During the summer work was carried out on the green space at Primrose Chase to improve the appearance of the area by removing accumulated fallen debris, invasive growth, low-hanging minor branches and to clear the base of tree trunks to allow grass to grow and make future maintenance easier. This was the final project from the Village Environmental Improvements Plan which was developed following consultation with residents via a survey conducted in 2021. There will be a new village survey in early 2026 and the results of this consultation will form the basis of a new plan for improvements in the village.

NEW ONLINE REPORTING TOOL

Cheshire East Council has launched a new online reporting tool to allow residents to report potholes and other local issues such as fallen trees, abandoned vehicles and fly-tipping within the area. The new tool, called traCE, replaces Fix My Street and is accessible at any time, from any device. It is a map-based platform that allows anyone to quickly and easily report issues, receive progress updates on previously reported issues and subscribe to reports raised by others.
